ENTRY SCHEDULE

1. **All Horticulture Entries (EXCEPT ROSES) will be accepted from 7:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m., Thursday, July 10.**
2. **ENTRIES must be picked up between 9 p.m. and 10 p.m. on Sunday July 13.**
3. The decision of the judges will be final. Any interference with the judges will be cause for disqualifying his/her entry from competition.
4. Premium money and ribbons:
1st - \$4.00; 2nd - \$3.00; 3rd - \$2.00; 4th - ribbon only.
A Champion Award ribbon will be given in each of the following divisions: Artistic, Flowers (including potted and hanging plants), Fruits/Vegetables and the Rose Show.

3. Except for vegetables, containers must be furnished by exhibitor. There are bud vases available for single stem exhibits. Accessories are not encouraged. The show committee cannot be responsible for loss or damage to containers or accessories if used by the exhibitor.
4. **Only one (1) exhibit per lot per exhibitor.**
5. Five (5) extra points will be awarded to the exhibitor correctly naming varieties. (Except arrangements)

Advanced: One who has received more than three (3) blue ribbons.

AMATEUR ROSE SHOW

RULES

1. All roses must be home grown.
2. Exhibitor must furnish container (e.g. glass pop bottle). The show committee will not be responsible for loss or damage to containers.
3. *An exhibitor may make multiple entries per lot but you are limited to one entry per named variety.*
4. Five extra points will be awarded for each correctly identified entry.

- Lot 01- Hybrid Tea, White or near white - 1 disbudded stem
- Lot 02- Hybrid Tea, Yellow blend disbudded stem
- Lot 03- Hybrid Tea, Orange or orange blend - 1 disbudded stem

- Lot 05- Hybrid Tea, Red or red blend - 1 disbudded stem

- Lot 06- Hybrid Tea, Mauve or mauve blend - 1 disbudded stem
- Lot 07- Hybrid Tea, Apricot or apricot blend - 1 disbudded stem
- Lot 08- Grandiflora, White or near white - 1 or more blooms per stem
