Food items will also be accepted on Wednesday, July 9 from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. Horticulture entries will be accepted on Thursday morning, July 10 from 7:00 to 10 a.m. Rose Show entries will be accepted Saturday morning July 12 from 7 to 10 a.m.
- All exhibits must remain at the fair for the duration of the fair. All possible care will be taken to prevent damage or loss, but in no event will the County Fair management be responsible for damage or loss. No soiled articles will be accepted.
- Limit (1) entry in each lot number. Champion ribbons will be awarded at the discretion of the judge in all divisions.
